Junior Cotillion Program

Class of 2025

The program is based on the curriculum of Teresa Kathryn Grisinger Reilly, noted author of two volumes of her comprehensive children's etiquette books *Girls and Boys at the Table* and *Teens at the Table*. Reilly stresses a practical and natural approach to etiquette training. The program is designed to reinforce good manners taught at home as well as teach nuances of fine dining and specific social situations. In addition to table manners and ballroom basics, the teens will learn tips on grooming, how to eat different foods, make introductions, write social correspondence, the art of conversation and the tricky tactics of gracefully managing cell phones and email. Classroom instruction will be under the guidance of Dotty Kolb and Susan W. Osteen. Boys will learn lessons on how to be a gentleman as well as the art of proper dressing for all occasions.

Dance will include basic ballroom and shag. Classes will be taught by Seth and Jennifer Reimer along with Melissa May and Whit Blanton. Seth is co-owner and general manager of Miss Libby's School of Dance and Jennifer is the artistic director for the Rising Stars, Miss Libby's competitive dance team. Melissa May and Whit Blanton are active with the Sumter Shag Club.

Class Attire for Boys: Button Downs/Khakis (No Jeans or T-Shirts)

Class Attire for Girls: Step above School/Dressy Casual (NO Short Skirts, Jeans or T-Shirts)

Skirts/dresses must be no less than 4 inches above the knee.

If a young lady's dress isn't the proper length, she may be asked to leave. Slacks are permissible.
