## SUMTER MUSEUM SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2024

Sumter Museum will award a \$1,000 scholarship to a high school senior graduating in the spring of 2024 in Sumter County.

Applicants must be residents of Sumter County, show academic accomplishments and potential, and should have an interest in pursuing further study in history or other areas of the social sciences.

Applications are available through the guidance departments of local high schools, and at the office of the Sumter Museum, located at 122 North Washington Street. Applications must be received **NO LATER THEN FEBRUARY 28, 2025.** 

Applications will be judged by an independent scholarship committee whose decision will be final. Applications will be judged primarily on merit; however, the committee may also consider financial need when appropriate.

Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the 2025 Sumter Museum Recognition Program on Sunday, March 16<sup>th</sup>.

Sumter Museum will mail a check for the scholarship amount directly to the college or university in which the recipient has enrolled. The award money is to be used only for academic tuition and/or fees.
